## CV HRISTOV S.

Slavča Hristov has been a full professor since 2004 at the Faculty of Agriculture, University of Belgrade. He delivers lectures and practical exercises to students in undergraduate, master's, specialist, and doctoral studies within the Animal Sciences programs, covering subjects in the narrow scientific field of health protection of domestic and farm animals (farm animal health, epizootiology, hygiene, behaviour, stress, welfare, biosecurity, and reproductive disorders). He has also taught students at the Faculty of Agriculture in Novi Sad and East Sarajevo, the Faculty of Biotechnology in Podgorica, and the College of Agriculture and Food in Prokuplje, on topics related to animal health care.

Professor Slavča Hristov has published more than 340 papers in international and national journals and in the proceedings of scientific conferences at both national and international levels

He has supervised the preparations and defences of seven doctoral dissertations and three master's theses, and has served as a committee member for the evaluation and defences of master's, specialist, and doctoral theses in 24 committees at the Faculties of Agriculture in Belgrade and Novi Sad, the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in Belgrade, and the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Skopje. He has also mentored or participated in the defence of 107 final theses across multiple institutions, including the Faculty of Agriculture in Belgrade, Novi Sad, East Sarajevo, and the Higher Agricultural and Food School of Vocational Studies in Prokuplje.

Professor Hristov has taken part in 12 national scientific and technological projects and 7 international projects. As a member of the Management Committee (MC), he participated in the COST Action CA15134 (GroupHouseNet) and is currently involved in two COST Actions— CA20103 (Better) and CA21124 (LIFT)—in the same capacity. He currently serves as the contact person for the Erasmus+ project HEAL-in-ONE at the University of Belgrade, which acts as the project coordinator. The project focuses on improving learning and teaching methodologies in higher education institutions.
